Harvest Report: The alluvial soils of Hester Creek's Block 16 are ideal for growing our bright and beautiful Trebbiano — planted in 1968 and still the only one in the Okanagan. In 2015, an early start and record-setting temperatures resulted in juicy ripeness, while careful canopy management, controlled drip irrigation and cool fall nights helped achieve perfect balance.

Winemaking: To get the best expression of character from the fruit of these 48-year-old vines, there is minimal intervention in the winery. After de-stemming, half the berries are lightly crushed and the other half left intact in order to strike the right balance between flavour and structure. Carefully selected yeasts and a cool ferment result in a bright and lively wine.

Tasting Notes: Fragrant notes of apple, pear and tropical fruit are backed by a distinct minerality. Beautifully weighted, the palate bursts with juicy grapefruit and melon. A crisp, lengthy finish makes this wine a perfect match for full-flavoured fare, or open a bottle on its own to sip with friends.
